Dr Caswell has retained the Presidency of the Australasian College of Aesthetic Medicine ACAM). Joining her on the board is Dr Matthew Holman as Vice President and Dr Nagd Farag, will be responsible for ACAM's Education portfolio. Dr Mutti Khan was reelected, unopposed, as Secretary, a role that he has completed well over the last two years.

Dr Caswell would like to thank retiring board member Dr Jass Narulla who has contributed to a number previous ACAM boards. Dr Narulla will continue to head up the ACAM Membership Committee after a successful 60% increase in new college members over the last 12 months.

Dr Farag will continue the work started by Dr Andrew Clark, who will fill a casual Director's position on the board. Dr Farag will assume the management of ACAM's education and fellowship programs. ACAM's educational partnership with the Queen Mary University of London and The University of South Wales (UK) continues to deliver well structured aesthetic medicine fellowship programs to members. Dr Clark is to be congratulated in successfully steering the development of these programs whilst managing the educational portfolio.

Through the development of strong management and educational programs, ACAM has evolved into a progressive, dynamic educational college which has been well received by doctors and nurses participating in the aesthetic medicine profession. Dr Caswell anticipates that ACAM will continue to see strong membership growth and further development of inter-collegiate relationships for the benefit of members. As part of this process, the college is currently undertaking a website rebuilt to better service its members and will soon launch a Course Merchant Dashboard for those courses accredited by ACAM.

ACAM continues to be an industry leader developing a medical ethics examination based on the Medical Board of Australia guidelines, which has been made commercially available (due to demand of non-college members). Dr Caswell stated "ACAM is in a strong position to provide avenues to world class and internationally recognised qualifications for its members. By doing so ACAM leads the way in shaping ethical education in the area of aesthetic medicine."



She continued, "This is a proud achievement that all board members, with diligence and vigour, have contributed to. Each board member is well pleased with what they have achieved on behalf of the members, in a relatively short period of time. I think that I speak for the board when I say thank you to the members in placing their trust in each of us and the plans we have laid out for ACAM's future development."
